**EXECUTIVE ORDER**  
**(No. 02 Series of 2021)**

**AN ORDER ESTABLISHING ENHANCED PREVENTIVE MEASURES  
AMID THE MOST RECENT COVID-19 SITUATION  
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONGABONG, ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**WHEREAS**, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a pandemic, and on March 08, 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation No. 922, which placed the Philippines under a State of Public Health Emergency;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bongabong has previously issued Executive Orders mandating a strict community quarantine, restricting the movement of people and goods, and enhancing border control within an area where a positive COVID-19 case has been reported;

**WHEREAS**, in spite of the measures from the national government, the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro and LGU of Bongabong, the threat of the virus within the municipality is still imminent and unremitting posing health risks to its local residents, not to mention its crippling effect to the local economy;

**WHEREAS**, for the safety and protection of all its residents and local communities within the municipality, there is a need to implement an intensified campaign against COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, to prevent further local transmission and spread of COVID-19 in the Municipality of Bongabong, and upon consultation to the local Inter-Agency Task Force and other stakeholders;

**NOW, THEREFORE I, ELEGIO A. MALALUAN**, Municipal Mayor of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order establishing enhanced preventive measures amid the most recent covid-19 situation in the Municipality of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro

**SECTION 1. NEW GUIDELINES ON PUBLIC GATHERINGS**

As per IATF Guidelines for Areas Placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ), mass gatherings such as but not limited to, religious services, work conferences, sporting events, and other entertainment activities shall be allowed provided that participants shall be limited to fifty percent (50%) of the seating or venue capacity. However, in the light of the recent COVID-19 situation in Bongabong, the following protocols/measures are to be followed;

- A. The resumption of operations of cockfighting in Bongabong is revoked due to the recent incident where two spectators have tested positive for COVID-19;
- B. Those who may want to pay their respects or express their sympathy to a deceased person and the bereaved immediate family may visit the funeral wake only for a brief period, but are not allowed to stay for a vigil or "*lamay*" to prevent mass gathering;
- C. Large gathering for wedding ceremonies and the ensuing reception activities are temporarily prohibited as well. Wedding ceremonies may push through with the attendance of the couple, select immediate families, and one set of sponsors only, and upon the discretion and approval of the Local Chief Executive.

## **SECTION 2. STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF GENERAL HEALTH PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES, WEARING OF FACE SHIELDS IN PARTICULAR**

- A. There shall be a strict implementation of the wearing of full-coverage face shields, together with face masks or other facial protective equipment, for those who are outside their residences or in public areas as mandated under IATF Guidelines (Resolution No. 88, Series of 2020);
- B. Minimum public health standards shall be complied with at all times within the municipality --- wearing of face masks/shields, observing social distancing, and frequent sanitizing/disinfection.

## **SECTION 3. ENHANCED BORDER CONTROL**

The barangay officials of the different barangays in the municipality, particularly those areas with known confirmed positive cases, are strongly encouraged to implement an enhanced border control, or localized lockdown if deemed necessary, upon consultation and subject to approval of the local IATF and the Local Chief Executive to arrest and contain local transmission.

The PNP Municipal Police Station are instructed to conduct checkpoints at the municipal boundaries, or at strategic locations, to monitor and control the ingress and egress of travelers to and fro Bongabong.

## **SECTION 4. REPEALING CAUSE**

All rules and regulations, executive orders, memoranda, or any part thereof, previously promulgated in conflict with or contrary to these Executive Order or any portion thereof, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

## **SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

If any portion or provision of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other portions or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced unless revoked or amended. Let copies of this Order be furnished to all concerned for their information, guidance, and action.
