EXECUTIVE ORDER
(No. 03 Series of 2021)

**AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE
INTER-AGENCY IMPLEMENTATION BODY KNOWN AS THE
ROAD-CLEARING TASK FORCE (RCTF) OF BONGABONG.**

WHEREAS, on July 22 during His Excellency Pres. Rodrigo Duterte's 4th State of the Nation Address (SONA), he instructed all public officials and concerned agencies to exercise their full authority to reclaim public spaces, specifically roads and other thoroughfares, which have already been illicitly occupied and used as expansion of make-shift vending stores and similar enterprises/establishments;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) through Memorandum Circular 2019-121 enjoins all local officials to exercise their powers essential to reclaim public roads which are being used for private purposes and in the process, rid them of illegal structures and constructions;

WHEREAS, the DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-121 has given the LCEs the mandate to revoke permits that give authority to private entities to occupy public roads, alleys, and other thoroughfares;

WHEREAS, DILG Sec. Eduardo M. Año reiterated that non-compliant and negligent provincial governors, Local Chief Executives, Punong Barangays and all other concerned, will be meted with appropriate administrative cases;

WHEREAS, it is the priority thrust of the Platform of Governance under the Local Chief Executive's current administration in the Municipality of Bongabong to develop and implement more programs/projects maintaining Peace and Order within the territorial jurisdiction of the LGU;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Bongabong recognizing that the various offices/departments of the Local Government Unit (LGU) should accomplish tasks delegated to their respective offices, while working hand in hand to carry out the goal of abiding by the President's directive;

WHEREAS, the LGU sees the need to ensure strict compliance with the President's directive and the DILG memo, but more than anything, to address public space and road congestion for ease of pedestrian movement and smooth traffic flow for the benefit of the local constituents;

NOW, THEREFORE I, ELEGIO A. MALALUAN, Municipal Mayor of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the Road-Clearing Task Force (RCTF) for the Municipality of Bongabong.

Section 1. REORGANIZATION OF THE TASK FORCE

The Inter-Agency Implementation Task Force for the Municipality of Bongabong, known as the Road-Clearing Task Force (RCTF), acting as the implementing body to carry out and follow-through the planned public road-clearing ops in the municipality, pursuant to DILG Memorandum Circular 2019-121, shall be reorganized due to some changes in personnel and/or their designation arising from transfer of office, and to add new team members.

Section 2. NEW COMPOSITION

The Road-Clearing Task Force (RCTF) shall now comprise the following individuals listed below.

Section 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

A. The Road-Clearing Task Force (RCTF) shall have the General Duties And Functions to wit:

1. hold meeting to draft a plan, organize, and implement the operation of the Task Force, how to go about with the clearing of all sort of obstruction on roads, sidewalks and road right-of-ways.
2. oversee the over-all operation of the road-clearing activities ensuring the safety of the task force members and its auxiliary personnel, and of the general public.
3. after executing the road-clearing ops, ensure that there would be rehabilitation works, strategy to address displacement, and sustainability mechanism in place.
4. conduct dialogue with residential owners, business establishment owners, and sidewalk vendors who will be affected by the road clearing operations to discuss the proceedings of the road clearing operations.
5. monitor its implementation to see to it that the operation is within the timeline and bounds of existing laws and local policies;
6. take the lead and ensure that barangay captains within their jurisdiction are cooperating and compliant, and those who will fail to act and be complicit by tolerating road obstructions shall be held accountable.
7. lobby for the budget allocation and eventual institutionalization of the operation and measures the Task Force would carry out to successfully claim the public roads of the municipality;
8. formulate means for the information, education, and communication (IEC) of the general public on the rationale and significance behind the operations of the Task Force.
9. asses, review, and evaluate the progress and accomplishment of the road-clearing ops, resolve any problems identified, and report the progress to the LCE.

B. The various offices/agencies concerned in the operation of the Road-Clearing Task Force (RCTF) shall have these Identified and More Specific Duties And Functions:

1. Municipal Engineering Office (MEO) – identify specific areas to be cleared out and provide directory of all residential/commercial establishments that go against the DILG Circular. Spearhead the rehabilitation works of the reclaimed public roads by placing street names and signs, among others, and come up with the progress report to be submitted to the Task Force Head.
2. Sangguniang Bayan – revisit ordinances and similar legislative measures to ensure responsiveness to this presidential directive in consistent with existing laws and policies.



3. MSWDO – ensure the welfare of those people affected by the road-clearing operations to address the displacement issues, particularly local residents who are considered indigents.
4. MDRRMO – provide the much needed personnel and make sure they have the resources e.g. hard hats, safety gears, and equipment to be used in the operation. They would be at the forefront of operation so it is imperative to coordinate with the PNP during operation.
5. HRMO – The Human Resource Office shall take care of the manpower resources, designating the right people for the job in order for the Task Force operation to be a success. Coordinate with the Budget Office as to the payroll of the personnel involved.
6. MAssO – work hand in hand with Engineering Office in the creation of the directory pertaining to the titles and other zoning issues that might arise from the operation.
7. MHO – make sure there would be standby medical staff on-site in cases of exigencies and other untoward incidents.
8. ABC (Liga ng mga Barangay) – make sure the information regarding the DILG memorandum circular is clearly disseminated to every Barangay Office and see to it that everyone would comply with the directives, and ensure sustainability mechanisms after the road-clearing operations.
9. MENRO and MPDC – provide the much needed technical know-how with regards to the over-all operation of the Task Force, and coordinate with the other offices concerned.
10. LEEPU – hold dialogue to inform commercial establishments and street vendors especially those along the business district areas like the local public market on the rationale behind the road-clearing ops.
11. PNP, BFP – provide the necessary manpower and authority on-site at the day of the road-clearing operations.

C. The Secretariat


There shall be a Secretary who shall be responsible for providing technical and administrative support to the Task Force, draft the necessary letters/correspondence, document meetings and operation proceedings including photos, and to do research and provide relevant/needed information to aid the Task Force.

Section 4. FUNDING

The funding requirements for the administrative and operational activities of the Road-Clearing Task Force (RCTF) shall be charged against any available funds of the LGU upon the discretion of the Municipal Budget Office.

Section 5. REPEALING CAUSE

All rules and regulations, executive orders, office orders, memoranda, or any part thereof, previously promulgated in conflict with or contrary to these Executive Order or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any portion or provision of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other portions or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced unless revoked or amended. Let copies of this Order be furnished to all concerned for their information, guidance, and action.
