**EXECUTIVE ORDER**  
(No. 07 Series of 2021)

**AN ORDER CONSTITUTING THE LOCAL CULTURE AND ARTS  
DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL, AND DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS, OF  
THE MUNICIPALITY OF BONGABONG, ORIENTAL MINDORO.**

**WHEREAS**, Sections 14, 15, 16 and 17, Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution declare that the State shall foster the preservation, enrichment and dynamic evolution of a Filipino culture based on the principle of unity in diversity in a climate of free artistic and intellectual expression.;

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution likewise mandates the State to conserve, develop, promote and popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resources, as well as artistic creations.

**WHEREAS**, it further provides that all the country's artistic and historic wealth constitutes the cultural treasure of the nation and shall be under the protection of the State, which may regulate its disposition.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ELEGIO A. MALALUAN, O.D.** , Municipal Mayor of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the constitution of the Municipal Cultural Development Council as a coordinating and advisory body for the Municipal Cultural Development Office.

**Section 1. COMPOSITION.** The Municipal Culture and Arts Development Council shall be composed of the following:

**Section 2. The following shall be the duties and functions of the Local Culture and Arts Development Council:**

As per DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2002-81 or The Creation of Local Culture and The Arts Council:

1. Prepare an annual plan on culture, arts, and cultural heritage consonant with the Philippine Development Plan for Culture and the Arts, to be integrated in local development plan and considered in the annual appropriation ordinances;
2. Formulate programs and recommendations to develop and sustain local cultural and artistic talents, cultural industries, traditional and contemporary arts and crafts, and their processes;
3. Coordinate with the appropriate affiliated cultural agencies of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) for the conservation and monitoring of national cultural properties found in the LGU;
4. Conduct cultural events such as cultural festivals, competition, lectures, seminars and symposia;
5. Identify such other programs and activities for the promotion of local cultural heritage and arts.

As per Republic Act No. 10066 or The National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009:

1. Ensure the protection, preservation, conservation and promotion of the local cultural and historical heritage;
2. Declare and maintain Local Heritage Zones;
3. Establish a Local Registry of Cultural Property;

As per Republic Act No. 7355 or Gawad ng Manlilikha ng Bayan Act:

1. Acknowledge the importance of traditional folk artist as singular conduit between skills of the past and the future;
2. Revitalize a community's artistic tradition thereby protecting a valuable fact of Philippine culture;

3. Provide mechanism for identification and assistance for qualified traditional folk artists to transfer their skills to the community; and,
4. Create opportunities for popularizing their works locally.

### **Section 3. REPEALING CAUSE**

All rules and regulations, executive orders, office orders, memoranda, or any part thereof, previously promulgated in conflict with or contrary to these Executive Order or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

### **Section 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

If any portion or provision of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other portions or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

### **Section 5. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced unless revoked or amended. Let copies of this Order be furnished to all concerned for their information, guidance, and action.
