EXECUTIVE ORDER
(No. 41 Series of 2022)

**AN ORDER CONSTITUTING A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE
CREATION OF THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE
TRADE AGREEMENT INVOLVING THE BAGSAKAN CENTER OF BONGABONG,
ORIENTAL MINDORO**

WHEREAS, Bongabong is a coastal municipality situated in the eastern side of Oriental Mindoro and has an estimate of 80,000 inhabitants, an estimate of 15,000 belonging to Mangyan tribe. Similarly, Bongabong boasts of an agriculture heavy economy and is also known as the Organic Farming Capital of Oriental Mindoro;

WHEREAS, Sangguniang Bayan of Bongabong Resolution No. 278 Series of 2020 expresses the intent of the Municipality of La Trinidad, Benguet to forge a sisterhood agreement with the Municipality of Bongabong; the Sisterhood Agreement between the Municipal Government of La Trinidad, Benguet and the Municipal Government of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro shall promote and expand an effective and mutually beneficial cooperation for the development of both local government units, within the limits of their financial and material capabilities, as well as foster a meaningful technical exchange and cooperation for sustainable development, trade and investments, tourism, information technology, human development, as well as culture and arts;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bongabong and the Municipality of La Trinidad being known in their respective provinces as centers of agriculture has a mutual interest in terms of economy and trade;

WHEREAS, the concept of Bagsakan Center was introduced through the Accelerated Hunger-Mitigation Program (AHMP), a landmark program of the Arroyo Government, to look at how more food can be produced and how food can be efficiently delivered to consumers, especially to the poorest of the poor consumers;

WHEREAS, aside from food security, a major concern of the agricultural sector is enhancing the incomes of farmers as this will ultimately encourage greater farm productivity;

WHEREAS, the establishment of Bagsakan Center will make basic commodities affordable for its consumers and provide direct selling outlet for farmers' products within and in nearby areas;

NOW, THEREFORE I, ELEGIO A. MALALUAN, Municipal Mayor of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby establish the Technical Working Group for the Creation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations for the Trade Agreement of the Local Government Unit of Bongabong;

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

The Technical Working Group shall have the following functions and duties:

1. To conduct financial analysis and feasibility study to identify and assess the opportunities and threats present, the resources required, and for efficient and effective planning of the establishment of a Bagsakan Center;
2. To formulate a value chain detailing the process involved in the trade agreement as part of a strategic plan to determine the inbound and outbound logistics, operations, etc. of the project;
3. To oversee that the operation- from the production process to the regulation of prices- is consistent with the projected and planned direction;
4. To establish and adhere to an achievable timeline which covers the initial phase of the technical working group orientation to the formulation and actual issuance of the Implementing Rules and Regulation for the trade agreement;
5. To hold regular meeting whenever deemed necessary;
6. Perform such other duties and functions necessary to carry out its mandated functions and responsibilities as authorized by law or ordinance and or/ as directed by the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CAUSE

All rules and regulations, executive orders, memoranda, or any part thereof, previously promulgated in conflict with or contrary to these Executive Order or any portion thereof, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any portion or provision of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other portions or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced unless revoked or amended. Let copies of this Order be furnished to all concerned for their information, guidance, and action.
