

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2019-01  
Series of 2019

WHEREAS, Commission on Audit Circular No. 75-6 dated November 7, 1975 prescribes the regulations on the use of government motor vehicles, aircrafts and watercrafts;

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 239 issued by the Office of the President of the Philippines prohibits the use of government vehicles for purposes other than official business;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Bongabong has recently acquired a coaster, the use of which must be regulated;

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bongabong in session duly assembled -

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES ON THE OFFICIAL USE OF THE MUNICIPAL COASTER VEHICLE BY OTHER GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS OR EMPLOYEES

Section 1. Scope- This Ordinance shall govern the use of the newly acquired coaster vehicle of the Municipal Government of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro;

Section 2. Authorized Use – The coaster vehicle shall be used for official travel or purpose of the Municipal Government of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro.

The Municipal Mayor may allow the use thereof for official travel or purpose by officials of the component barangays of the Municipality of Bongabong, and other government officials or employees like the Department of Education and other national government agencies holding office in the Municipality of Bongabong, by members of LGU-created councils, and by duly-accredited associations, organizations or cooperatives, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. There is a written request to the Municipal Mayor supported by official invitation to the participants;
2. The request is approved by the Municipal Mayor;
3. The activity to be attended is an official activity;
4. Overloading is strictly prohibited;
5. The expenses for the fuel and other related expenses shall be the responsibility of the borrower;

Section 3. Penalty Clause- Violation of this Ordinance shall subject the violator to liabilities as prescribed under existing laws, rules or regulations;

Section 4. Separability Clause- If for any reason any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effectivity Clause – This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval.
